## Letter From The Executive Director

You can measure progress any number of ways. We measure it by milestones. Every life we make easier through our services, programs and Clinical Trials is itself a milestone.

We don't distinguish between major and minor milestones because each one represents progress. And achieving success at Body Positive is defined by the progress we make in caring for HIV-positive men, women and children, not only in Arizona but around the world.

Progress doesn't often come quickly or easily. Small advances add up. Setbacks only increase our resolve. We will not let the rising infection rate among teens, the elderly and minority populations move us off course. Instead, we're working harder to reach out to those at risk with information about education and prevention.

We have an obligation to the thousands of HIV-infected individuals in our community we know about – and those still out there either refusing to admit they're infected or afraid to find out – to continue leading the fight. We have a similar obligation to the many wonderful and generous supporters of Body Positive who know that their efforts on our behalf are not in vain.

That's why each milestone is so important. There were many to be proud of during 2004 starting with the ten-year anniversary of the Clinical Trials Program. Over that period, under the remarkable vision of Medical Director Dr. Andy Myers, Body Positive has become a national model of excellence and efficiency.



Of the 23 drugs approved for use by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), 18 were tested at Body Positive. Because of those tests, hundreds of clinical trial volunteers in our community received no-cost medication to treat the disease and, as a result, literally thousands – perhaps even millions – of men, women and children in the U.S. and abroad have access to them.

Among the trials currently underway at Body Positive are studies to determine the efficacy of a vaccine designed to prevent the spread of the disease from one person to another and a new single-dose pill that will eliminate the need to take medications by the handful every day.

As part of our long-term goal to expand both our capabilities and our reach, Body Positive became a licensed Behavioral Health Facility in 2004, enabling us to address the issue of HIV and AIDS with additional complementary programs and services. We have hired Dr. David Masselli to direct the Behavioral Health programs.

Also in 2004, we launched the Kirk D. Baxter Wellness Center, named for Body Positive's founder and first executive director, as another resource in our holistic approach to treating HIV. And, we brought "Logan's Playground" under the Body Positive umbrella to provide operational support for the program that offers childcare and other services to HIV-infected and affected women, their children and families. Logan's Playground keeps alive the memory of Logan Shaver, who succumbed to AIDS at the age of six.

One of the year's newest outreach efforts brings together HIV prevention workers and behavioral health professionals to target high-risk, sexually active young gay and bisexual men. Through a series of sexual health seminars, these men are empowered and mobilized to focus on problem-solving, reality testing and socialization skills, and are connected to long-term services and programs.

Body Positive also has added new and innovative programs to meet the needs of the increasing number of women and families we serve. Retreats, luncheons, special women's clinic days and children's programs have provided support and friendship to this growing client base.

This May, we'll celebrate another milestone: the tenth anniversary of Night for Life, our most important fund-raising event. The growth of Night for Life, in terms of attendance and the critical financial support that it generates, is a testament to the hard work and dedication of so many Body Positive volunteers.

We are truly grateful for their ongoing support and for the commitment of our staff who represent the face of this organization.

We look forward to what the future holds and to each milestone it brings.

## Letter From The Board Chair

After 13 years providing services and programs to a growing, and constantly changing, client base, Body Positive continues to grow in both importance and significance, locally and globally.

When Kirk Baxter became the first executive director in the early 1990s, Body Positive was little more than a three-person agency facing a giant challenge: dealing with a deadly disease most people didn't understand that primarily affected a community many people didn't like to admit existed.

Much has changed since then. Much hasn't. The gay community, particularly young gay and bisexual men, remains the most at-risk and affected by HIV. But the alarming infection rate among young heterosexual teenagers, people over 50 and in minority communities reflects a frightening trend: too many people aren't listening to what's being said or learning from what's taken place.

For those reasons, Body Positive's role and responsibilities take on increasing value to the community. On a global level, through the Clinical Trials Program, Body Positive is affecting people worldwide.

As a result, one of the biggest issues we face as a board of directors is how to find the most effective means of keeping pace with the growing needs of the community at the same time we maintain, or increase, our funding and fund-raising capabilities.

Addressing its **unpredictable nature** – how it **adapts and reconfigures itself** in different individuals as well as constantly changing human behavior requires *strategic ingenuity* and tactical flexibility.

There are many, many worthwhile organizations competing for support and fund-raising dollars. The recent tsunami proved once again that Americans are quick to generously react to emergencies anywhere in the world.

We know that as Body Positive has identified needs and developed programs and services to address them, the community has responded financially as well as through volunteer hours and by other means of support. As we continue to grow, those resources – and those responses – will become increasingly important to what we are able to accomplish.

By becoming a licensed Behavioral Health Center last year, Body Positive added a critical component to our healthcare menu. We want to maintain that momentum as we move toward building an even broader, more diversified "campus of care" in the years ahead.

We are exploring a number of ideas and pursuing other potential opportunities that will further enhance Body Positive's ability to respond to the evolving needs of the community, not just for those infected by HIV but those affected by the disease as well.

Among our priorities is the need to keep pushing education and prevention messages deeper and deeper into the community. One of the most critical audiences for messages about HIV and the danger of high-risk behaviors are parents. We must give them the tools and the knowledge to talk honestly and openly with their children as they move from young teenagers to sexually active adults. Body Positive staff member Alexis Smith is on loan to the Arizona Parent Teacher Association (PTA) as a consultant in that effort.

Body Positive, under the leadership of Executive Director Brian Helander and his terrific management and support team, has strengthened its credibility and leadership role in the ongoing struggle to take control of the disease and its repercussions.

We are very proud of what they have achieved and of the board's role in helping to provide fiduciary and financial direction to the organization. It is a responsibility we take, individually and collectively, with singular commitment. And, it is a responsibility that brings with it the need to consistently do more for which we need your ongoing support.

## A Year of Achievement

In 2004, Body Positive expanded resources, capabilities and programs to meet the ever-shifting needs of the HIV-infected community.

Body Positive achieved a critical milestone with formal licensing as a behavioral health facility, with leadership from Director Dr. David Masselli. The Body Positive Behavioral Health Outpatient Clinic will link behavioral health and HIV prevention, coping and survival through programs and support groups for adjustment, depression, behavioral issues, anxiety disorders, relationship issues, substance abuse, grief and loss, sexual identity and psychological testing. Targeted behavioral health support groups offer help for HIV-positive women, HIV-infected gay men, and HIV-infected straight men and women, including a focus on people of color and those co-infected with Hepatitis C.

## Wellness

The Kirk Baxter Wellness Center, which opened in 2004, coordinates alternative and complementary medical services and programs, nutrition services and the Vitamin and Herb Shop. The goal is to help HIV-infected individuals deal with a variety of health-related issues ranging from weight loss to general physical well being to side effects from the powerful HIV medications.

More than 1300 men, women and children received treatment from our registered dietitians, naturopathic doctors and with products from the Vitamin and Herb Shop last year. The Vitamin and Herb Shop distributed products valued at more than \$300,000. Approximately 82% of the clients received vitamins and herbs at no cost.

During the past year, Body Positive provided over 3,800 hours of behavioral health support to more than 1,200 individuals, both on-site and through outreach and prevention activities in the community. More than 8,000 clients, families and community members received 40,000 class hours of HIV education and support.

Body Positive also brought Logan's Playground in house. This program for children and families created in honor of Logan Shaver who passed away from AIDS at the age of six, assists families with child care during appointments, classes and support groups. 800 hours of childcare were provided to clients who were accessing primary care in the McDowell Clinic and support services at Body Positive. Additionally, 76 families received respite care through Positive Pals, Emergency Respite and Saturday "KidsTime" programs.

## Clinical Trials

The Body Positive Clinical Trials program again made significant contributions by testing new and cutting-edge medications to treat HIV and AIDS. Among the most notable were a new vaccine designed to prevent the spread of HIV from one person to the next, and a single-dose daily pill that may, if proven, eliminate the need to take medications by the handful that has impact around the world.

Under the leadership of Medical Director Dr. Andy Myers, Body Positive participated in 32 clinical trials in 2004, servicing 178 volunteer clients from 18 to 55 years of age. The breakdown of clinical trials volunteers included 92% men and 8% women.

Participation in the trials includes medical exams, lab tests, analysis and the life-saving drugs through funding by pharmaceutical companies sponsoring the research. As a result, the volunteers received approximately \$1 million in products and services at no cost to them.

Body Positive has tested 18 of the 23 medications currently approved to treat HIV by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), pushing the agency's reach far beyond the borders of Arizona into the worldwide fight against HIV.

## Fund Raising

Once again Body Positive demonstrated its creative touch in the fund-raising arena.

Marc Reid, Robert Black and Larry Stewart co-chaired An Evening of Positive Energy to kick off the year's fund raising in January with a new event featuring the sensational Dragapella act, The Kinsey Sicks.

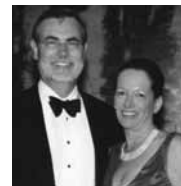

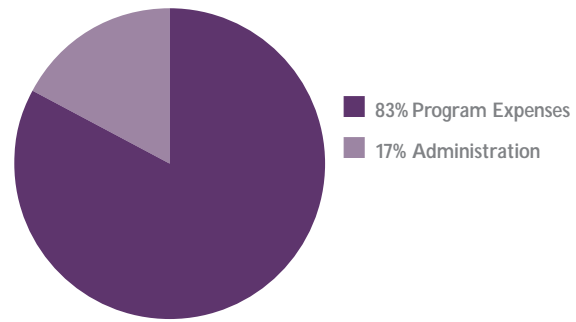

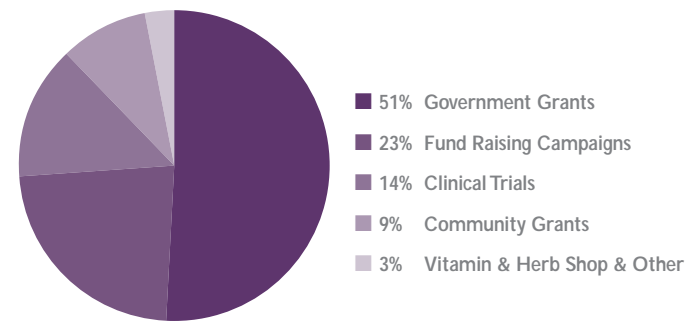
